SUGGESTIONS FOR A REVISION OF *HUI I* & *HUI II*  
AND THE NEED FOR THE WRITING OF

*Hebrew-Ugaritic Index III*

*to the Writings of Mitchell J. Dahood (1981-1989):*

A Bibliography with Indices of Scriptural Passages, Hebrew, Ugaritic, and Eblaite Words, and Grammatical Observations.

An updating of Martinez' work is necessary because it does not include all of the publications by M. Dahood.

A thorough revision of Martinez' work is also desirable. My suggestions for a revision of Martinez' work include the following:

1. It should, of course, include the publications which are not listed in Martinez' volumes and Dahood's suggestions in these publications should be added to the indexes.
2. The revision should include extended indexes.

The present indexes are a good beginning, but lead to frustration because some of the desired information is not provided.

- . The "Index of Scriptural Passages" (Vol. I; "Scriptural Index," Vol II) should include the the words, *translations*, texts and grammatical issues discussed.
- . The "Index of Hebrew and Ugaritic Words" (Vol. I; "Index of Hebrew, Ugaritic, Eblaite, and Phoenician [Punic] words," Vol. II) should include the *English translation* of the words which was suggested by Dahood.

- 
- . The "Index of Grammatical Observations" should include the Biblical, Ugaritic, and other passages.
  - . The list of "Critical Reviews of M. J. Dahood's Major Works," in Vol. II, should be brought up to date.
  - . The list of "Doctoral Dissertations written under the direction of M. J. Dahood and Critical Reviews. Other Related Articles by these Authors," in Vol. II, should be brought up to date.
  - . The list of "Related Writings by other Authors," in Vol. II, could be expanded and serve as a beginning of a vast index on lexicography and grammar. It could serve as the foundation for a LEXICON AND GRAMMAR OF "NORTHWEST SEMITIC STUDIES" and their impact on the understanding of the consonantal text of the Masoretic text of the Tanakh. Such an "Index" should, of course (in these days), be stored electronically and be available electronically (on a CD, Internet, WWW, etc.). It could be constantly updated by various scholars throughout the world.

I plan to begin such a revision of *HUI I* and *HUI II* (depending on time and energy available to me). But, I think, I will, first, produce a manuscript (on disk, of course) of *HUI III*.

Mitchell Dahood died on March 8, 1982 in Rome at about 7:40pm in the Chapel of “Our Lady of the Well” of a massive heart attack.

I have been highly privileged to know M. Dahood since the Summer of 1966, when I was introduced to him by my advisor, Professor M. Mansoor, in Rome on the way to Israel. It was also

Prof. Mansoor who (during 1965/66) gave me some of Prof. Dahood's reprints. I have never been the same since and I have made it my task to read and study everything which Dahood has written. The time, which I have spent with Dahood's work, has deepened my understanding of Biblical Hebrew and of the Tanakh/OT beyond my wildest dreams--and my scholarly and spiritual journey continues (September 1995).
