ABOUT THE CONTENT OF THIS BIBLIOGRAPHY:

The following bibliography contains a *selection* from the vast literature on Job. It is mostly *limited* to

- publications since the discovery of the Ugaritic tablets (1929);
- works in German and English (a very serious limitation; publications in French, Spanish, Dutch, Hebrew, Spanish, Italian, ... should also be included and studied);
- writings in the area of Hebrew and Semitic studies (esp. Northwest Semitic Studies, i.e., Eblaite, Ugaritic, Hebrew, Aramaic-Syriac, Phoenician-Punic, ...) with an emphasis on philology;
- a limited selection of the more meditative, philosophical and theological studies (on themes like suffering, rhetoric, poetry, wisdom, theodice, etc.).

A most comprehensive, and excellently arranged bibliography on Job (i.e., by topics, areas, etc, and, therefore, it is hard to find all publications of certain authors) is now available in

Job 1-20. Word Biblical Commentary, Volume 17. Dallas, Texas: Word Books, 1989.

In the summer of 1991 I checked the bibliographies in Clines' commentary very carefully, and selected appropriate titles (I now, 1995, think that all of Clines' entrees should be put on disk).

But, of course, even the bibliography in the book by Clines is not complete. For example, it does not list all the publications which deal with the impact of Northwest Semitic studies on the book of Job. Clines is extremely sceptical (actually “condescending” would be a better word) of the NWS approach. His commentary, though, is the best *traditional* commentary since Fohrer’s work (1963 - the manuscript was completed in 1959!). I thought that a commentary of the caliber and extent of Fohrer’s or Dhorme’s would, probably, never be written again. I was wrong

THE HIGHLIGHTED COMMENTARIES AND BOOKS

The highlighted commentaries are those which “had the greatest survival value” according to David J. A. Clines (Word, 1989).

I agree with his choice of the 21 commentaries during the years from 1851-1985. Several more could have been chosen, but these 21 commentaries represent the best in about one hundred years of studies on Job.

I would add **Ball** (1922), **Tur-Sinai** (1967) and the publications based on Northwest Semitic studies: **Blommerde** (1969), **Michel** (1970), **Ceresko** (1980), the many contributions to Job studies by **Dahood** (see Martinez), and **Michel** (1987) which Clines excludes from his work on Job.

Since 1985 I would add **Hartley** (1988), and **Clines** (1989) as important contributions to the study of Job.

For my own use I highlighted several more books which I want to read as soon as possible.
